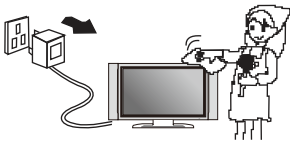
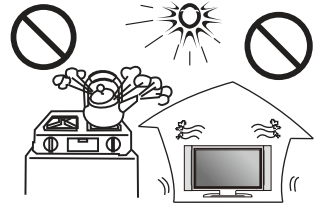
## Safety

Please immediately pull out the AC power plug of adapter if there is abnormal sound or smell or it has sound but no picture, and contact with maintenance station after confirming no abnormality.



TV should be kept free from rain, damp and dust for prevention of electric shock and short circuit.

TV should be kept from high temperature heating objects or direct sunlight. TV should be placed with good ventilation.

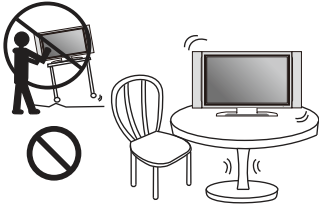

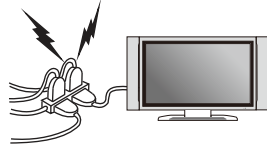
It's forbidden to contact the display with organic solvents such as alcohol or gasoline or chemical solvent such as acid or alkali, etc.





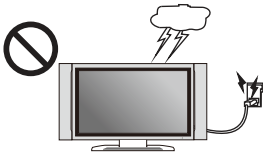
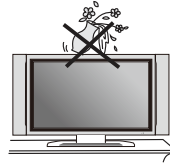
Do not put TV on unstable or shaky place

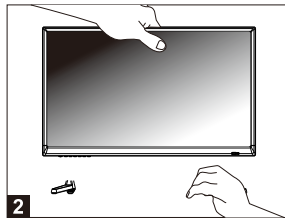
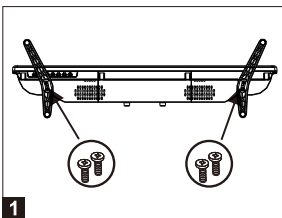
## II - Base Installation Guide

### The Way Of Installing Base:

(the stand approximately 180 degrees from horizontal).
2. Put the hole of the base upright into shaft of unit(as shown figure 2).
3. Fix the stand and the screen with 4 screws (figure 3)
4. The rendering after installed (as shown figure 4).

### The Way Of Unloading Base:

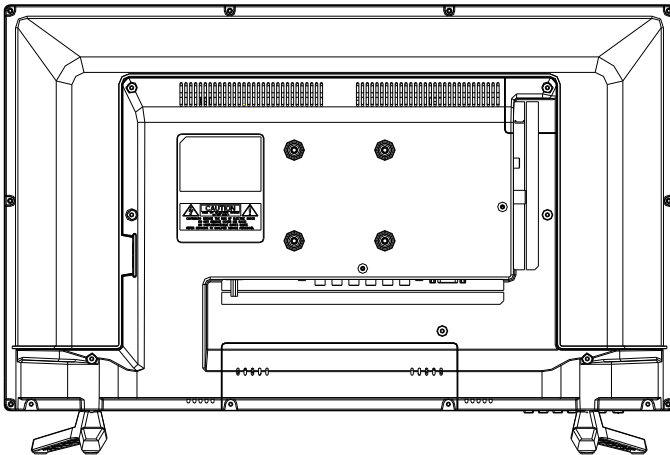


1. Please remove the screw between the base and shaft (as shown figure 1).

### III - Wall Mounting instructions

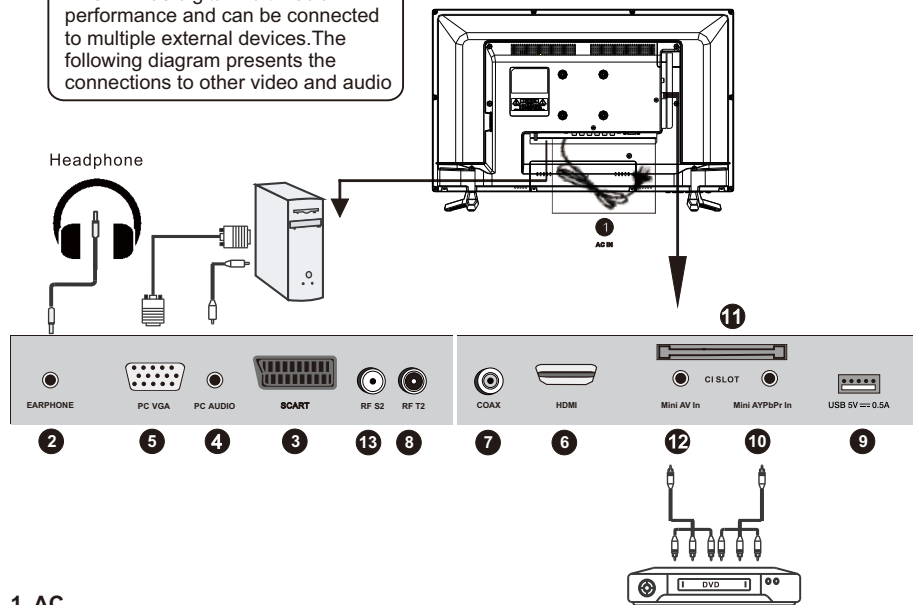

## BATTERY INSTALLATION

Install the batteries as shown in the following figures. Make sure the + and - terminals are positioned as indicated in the battery compartment (Fig. 1)-

### USEFUL DURATION OF BATTERIES

- Normally the batteries last for a year, even if the consumption of the batteries depends on the effective use of the remote control.
- If the remote control does not work when it is used near the appliance, replace the batteries.
- Use two dry type 2xAAA batteries (batteries not included ).

#### **NOTE:**

- Do not drop, step on or otherwise hit the remote control. This could damage the components or cause a malfunction.
- If the remote control is not used for a long time, remove the batteries.

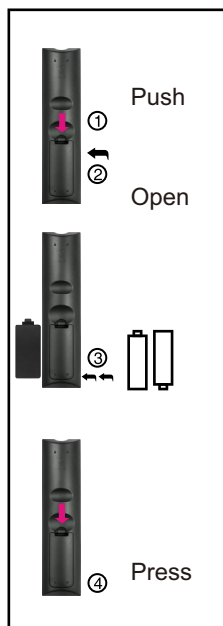
### OPERATION OF THE TV REMOTE

Point the remote control at a distance of no more than 6 m from the remote sensor and within an angle of 60 ° in front of the appliance (Fig. 2).

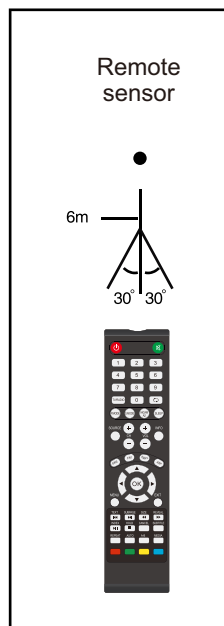
#### **NOTE:**

- The operating distance may vary depending on the brightness of the environment.
- Do not aim light sources at the remote sensor.
- Do not place any object between the remote control and the remote control sensor..
- Do not use this remote control when using the remote control of another device at the same time.

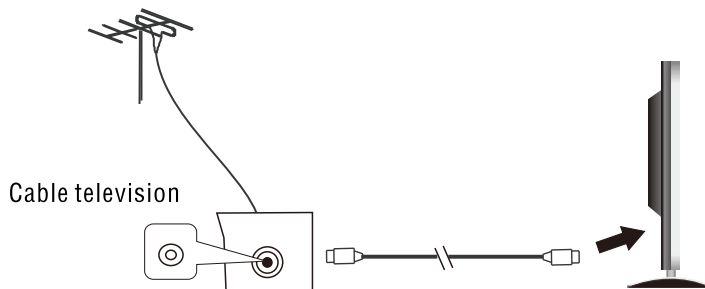


## VI - Antenna Connections

We recommend you use a 75Ω antenna cable so as to eliminate the disturbance caused by impedance mismatching. The antenna cable shall not be bundled together with the power cord.

Directly insert the 75Ω antenna cable plug into the antenna socket when applying cable television.

Note: The antenna should be checked periodically. If clear image is not available, shut down the power and then carefully check the antenna.



### Power-on/Power-off

1. Make sure all cables are disconnected from the main unit before connecting to the AC power source.
2. Read the instructions carefully before connecting other devices.

Press the standby button again on the remote control for the television the indicating lamp becomes green, and then television image is available.

Press the standby button on the remote controller or the television to enter into standby state.

### Power-saving & protection mode

1. In video or PC state, the television will enter into lower power sleep state (standby state) to conduct power saving and protection after several minutes with no signal inputs.

## VII - Watching Television Programs

MAKE SURE ALL THE EQUIPMENTS AND POWER CORD ARE CONNECTED PROPERLY AND THE UNIT IS SET IN CORRECT MODE BEFORE KINDS OF OPERATIONS.

### BASIC OPERATIONS

- Press POWER button on the unit or remote control to power ON the unit (indicator will glow green); press it again to power OFF (standby mode) the unit (indicator will glow red).
- Press SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to switch the unit to DTV or ATV mode.

#### SELECT DESIRED PROGRAM

1. Press CH+ button to play next channel.
2. Press CH- button to play previous channel.
3. Press number buttons on remote control directly to select desired program.

NOTE: Press +/- button repeatedly to switch the digit.

#### VOLUME CONTROL

- Press VOL+ or VOL- to adjust the level of current volume.
- Available range: 0-100.

#### MUTE CONTROL

- Press MUTE button to mute the sound, press it again to turn on the sound.

#### SOURCE SETTING

- Press SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to display the input source list.
  - Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select desired input source, then press OK button to confirm selection.
- Available options: DTV, ATV, YPbPr, SCART, AV, HDMI, USB, VGA.

#### MULTIAUDIO SATLLITE

- Press AUDIO button on remote control and use navigation buttons to select desired audio language.

NOTE: To enable this function, make sure that the channel you are viewing supports multi-audio languages.

#### INFORMATION DISPLAY

- Press DISPLAY button on remote control to display information of current program.

## VIII - First Time Installation

- The unit contains different setting menus. Once the initial programming is entered, it will be remained in the memory until change, and the unit can always be operated under the same conditions.
- The settings will be remained in the memory until the settings are changed, even after setting the player to standby mode.

Common procedure for initial settings

- Press MENU button on the unit or remote control to display the main menu.
- Press UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT navigation buttons to move the cursor.
- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter submenu.
- Press MENU button to save current setting and return to previous menu page.
- Press EXIT button to exit menu page.

First Time Installation

- Connect to power source and turn on this TV, then below setup page will display on the screen.
- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to move the cursor.
- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select an option.

Step 1

OSD Language: select the on-screen menu language.

Country: select your country.

Energy Model: select Home or Store mode.

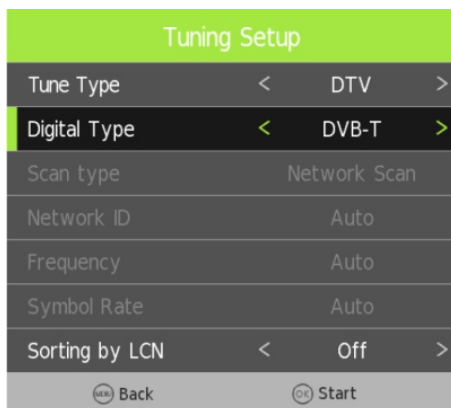
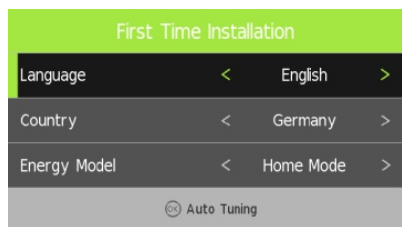
Step 2

- When Step 1 finished, press OK to enter next page.
- Use UP/DOWN navigation button to highlight an option and press OK to enter subpage.
- Select Tune Type and Digital Type using navigation buttons and press OK to start auto tuning.

NOTE: Items following Digital Type are adjustable only when Digital Type is DVB-T / C / S and these items vary for different digital type.

- Select an available input source.

NOTE: To play an external device, connect it to related terminal on TV back first.



## QUICK SELECT

When viewing an available channel, press CH.LIST button on remote control to enter Channel List menu page.

- Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select preferred channel.
- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select a channel group.
- Press OK button to confirm selection.

## TELETEXT

- Press TEXT button on remote control to display the available teletext information and press it repeatedly to stop playing the teletext.

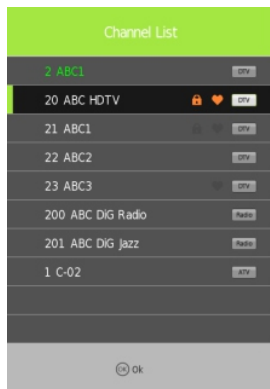

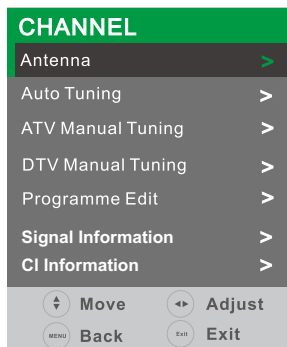
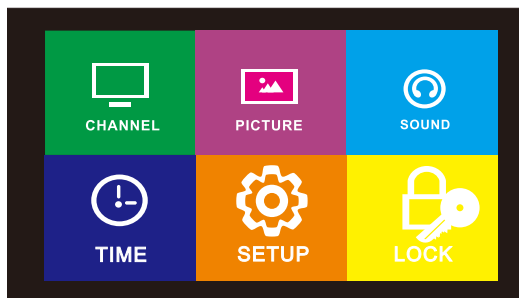
#### Remote operations when playing multimedia files:

NOTE: Users can see and set Tune Type and following items only when "Antenna" is DVB-C.

- When finished above settings, highlight "Auto Scan" and press OK to start program tuning.



### ATV Manual Tuning

Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it. Use LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select the channel. Then press OK button to start searching. Current channel: to select the current channel. Color system: to select the preferred color system. Sound system: to select the preferred sound system. Fine tuning: fine tuning of the frequency. AFC: activate / deactivate automatic control of the



### DTV Manual Tuning

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Use navigation buttons to adjust the select the desired channel number, start the search by pressing the OK button.

### Programme Edit

Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it. Press UP/DOWN navigation button to highlight desired channel.

Press RED button on remote control to delete highlighted channel.

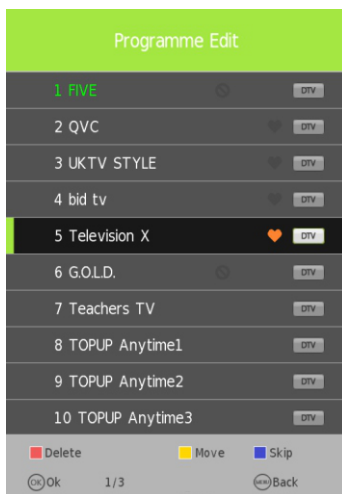

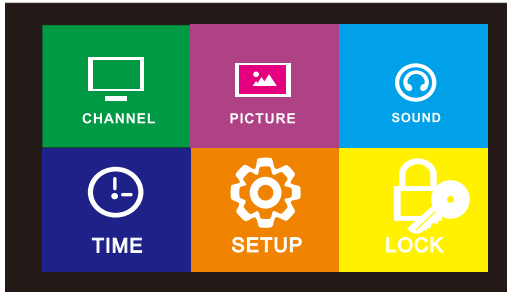

### Picture Mode

Available options: Personal, Mild, Standard, Dynamic.



### Contrast

The contrast value of picture can be adjusted from 0-100.

### Brightness

The brightness value of picture can be adjusted from 0-100.

### Colour

The colour saturation value of picture can be adjusted from 0-100.

### Tint

This item is used to adjust the tone of color in NTSC system from 0-100.

### Sharpness

The sharpness value of picture can be adjusted from 0-10.

**NOTE:** The value of Brightness, Contrast, Color, and Sharpness is adjustable only in User picture mode.

### Colour Temp

This item is used to adjust the optimum colour temperature for suitable viewing.

Available options: Normal, Cold, Warm

### Noise Reduction

This item is used to eliminate the image noise to gain better image effect.

Available options: Off, Low, Medium, High.

### SCREEN

setup the PC.

### Dynamic CR

Dynamic Contrast ON/OFF.

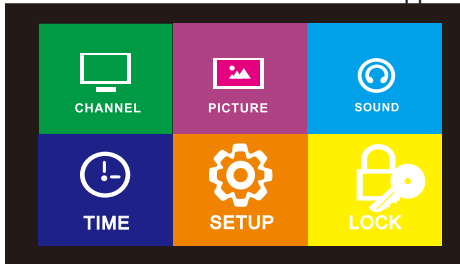
### Face Color

Adjust this option if face color displayed on screen looks a little abnormal.

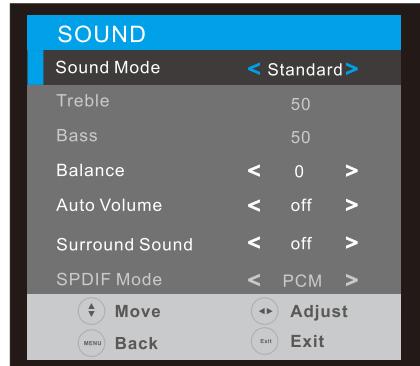
## Sound

1. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to enter the OSD menu, then press "▶" button to select the "Sound" menu.
2. Press the "OK" button to enter the "Sound" menu setting, use "▲ / ▼" to move the menu bar, and then press "◀ / ▶" button to adjust the value of selected item.
3. Press "MENU" button to return to upper menu.



### Sound Mode

Available options: Standard, Movie, Music, Sports, Personal.



### Treble

This item is used to adjust the level of higher-pitched sounds from 0-100.

NOTE: The value of Bass and Treble is adjustable only in Personal sound mode.

### Bass

This item is used to adjust the level of lower-pitched sounds from 0-100.

NOTE: The value of Bass and Treble is adjustable only in Personal sound mode.

### Balance

This item is used to adjust the audio output between left and right speaker from -50 to 50.

### Auto Volume

An automatic volume control automatically adjusts the volume or loudness, set it "ON" for an ambient volume to make the audio signal better heard.

### Surround Sound

Press the "▲ / ▼" button to select the "Surround Sound" item, and then use "▶" button to turn the surround sound function TruSurround/off.

### SPDIF Mode

Available options: Auto, PCM, Off.

### AD Switch

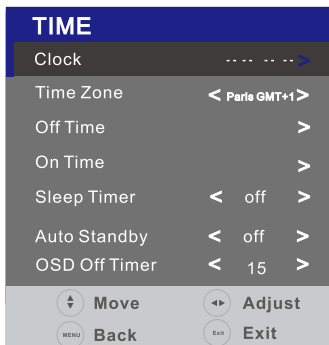
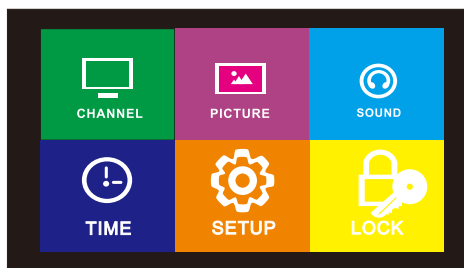
This item is used to turn on/off Audio Description function. For Visually Impaired users, this function can help to know a certain scene or action through the narration, instead of see it.

#### NOTES:

- AD Switch function works only when you are viewing programs that contain related narration information.
- The users can adjust AD Volume when AD Switch is on.

## TIME

1. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to enter the OSD menu, then press "▲ / ▼" button to select the "Time" menu.
2. Press the "OK" button to enter the "Time" menu setting, use "▲ / ▼" to move the menu bar, and then press "▶" button to adjust the value of selected item.

### **Clock**

It displays current system time when an available channel was saved.

### **Time Zone**

This item is used to select desired time zone.

### **Off Time**

This item is used to set the time to turn off the TV.

### **On Time**

This item is used to set the time to turn on the TV.

### **Sleep Timer**

This item is used to set the automatic sleep time when no signals.

Available options: Off, 10min, 20min, 30min, 60min, 90min, 120min, 180min, 240min

### **Auto Standby**

This item is used to select desired Auto Sleep (standby) duration when no operations were done through the remote control.

Available options: Off, 3/4/5 hours.

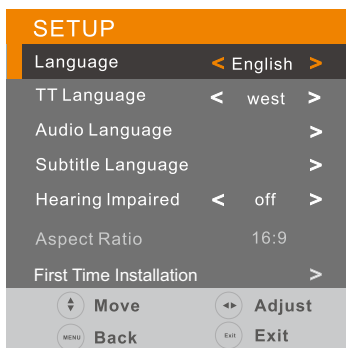
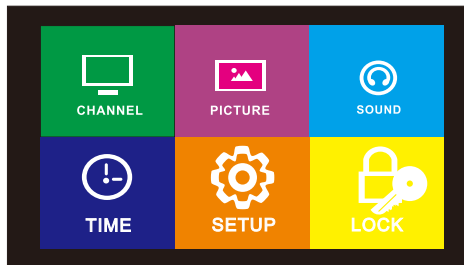
### **OSD off Timer**

This item is used to select desired OSD menu active time.

2. Press the "OK" button to enter the "Tine" menu setting, use "▲ / ▼" to move the menu bar, and then press "▶" button to adjust the value of selected item.
3. Press "MENU" button to return to upper menu.



### Language

This item is used to select desired on-screen display language.

### TT Language

This item is used to select desired teletext language.

### Audio Language

This item is used to select desired audio language.

### Subtitle Language

This item is used to select desired subtitle language.

### Hearing Impaired

This item is used to turn on/off Hearing Impaired function. For Hearing Impaired users, this function can assist help to know a certain scene or action through the caption, instead of hearing it.

**NOTE:** Hearing Impaired function works only when you are viewing programs that contain related caption information.

### Aspect Ratio

This item is used to adjust the video size.

Available options: Auto, 4:3, 16:9, Zoom1, Zoom2.

**NOTE:** The available video size may be different for different input source.

### First Time installation

With this option it is possible to call up the first installation menu.

### Energy Mode

This item is used to select Home Mode or Store Mode (the brightness is higher than Home Mode).

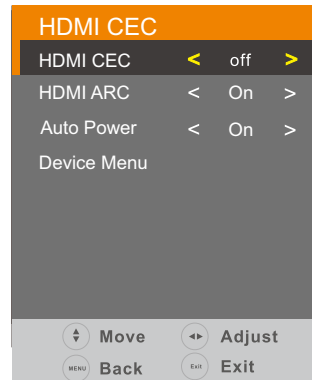

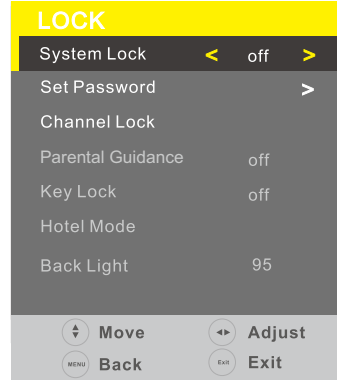
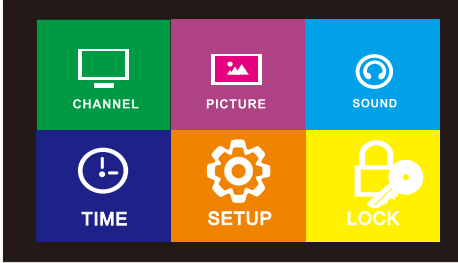

Max Volume: set the maximum volume level.

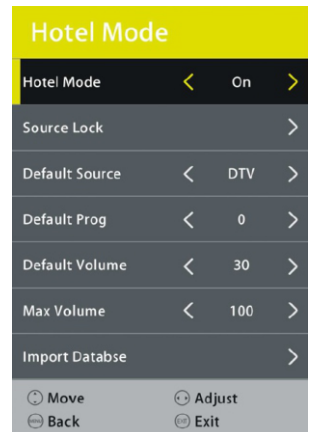








